Teaching Learning and Evaluation

 - (viii) Students get an exposure to diverse academic and professional perspectives, and experiences in various fields.

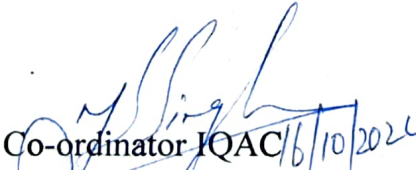
- xvi. Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) system, Effective and continuous internal evaluation system shall be implemented as follows:
